Contact Tracing over the Christmas Holiday

If a child in Nursery becomes a **confirmed case of coronavirus over the weekend** of Saturday 19th and Sunday 20th December, it is important that we know immediately so that we can contact parents and carers of other children within that bubble.

If this happens to your child on either Saturday or Sunday, please call the following mobile number 07769958497. We will then send a text message to those within the class bubble to alert them and send email messages to parents and carers to advise them what needs to be done. This would almost certainly be to inform you that your child would need to self-isolate for fourteen days (in that instance the rest of the family would not need to self-isolate unless someone in the house developed symptoms).

From Monday 21st December onwards, any child developing symptoms and then testing positive will not be considered to have been infectious while they were at school. This means that the other people in their bubble will not be a contact for the infectious person and we will therefore not need to notify them that they need to begin self-isolation.

This is summarised in the table below:

Notified individuals will have to self-isolate for 14 days	Unless symptoms started or the test took place before Monday 21 st December, the case was not in Nursery during the infectious period and therefore there is no need to contact Nursery on the emergency number.

If you do get a positive test result, call our dedicated number immediately (07769 958497) to tell us.

You only need to do this if the table above shows it is necessary, but if in doubt, call anyway.

This number is for telling us about positive test results only during the Christmas period. **Please do not use it for other purposes.**
