A total of £7,200 was received in Early Years Pupil premium (EYPP). The amount received per student is 0.53p. In the table above N1 refers to children who have received the full amount of £300 for the school year. N2 refers to children who have only received EYPP for part of the years. This amount estimated. A child that receives the funding for the whole year receives a total of £300, whereas children who only have received the funding for part of the year have been round to £100 for 1 term, and £200 for 2 terms.

In total 27 children received the EYPP. Of these 21 children received the funding for the whole year (N1). The gender spread was 13 female and 8 male. 6 children received the funding for part of the year (N1), 4 female and 2 male.

EAL group: refers to children who have received additional support in intervention groups where English is a 2nd language.

Key group support: refers to children who have additional support through targeted intervention with their key worker.

1:1: refers to children where the funding contributed towards the cost of either a Teaching assistant or therapist support.

All these children will be reported on, separately, in the data report that will form the foundation for further analysis when all assessments have been entered on the system. The full amount (£7,200) only fractionally contributes towards the cost of interventions.
