



The Fields Children's Centre Equality Information 2019/20

The Fields Children's Centre comprises of a day care provision, a nursery school provision and a Children's Centre.

The Field's Children's Centre provides:

- 100 part time places in education provision (15 hours per week)
- 74 full day care places for children 0 – 4years
- Wrap around childcare for working families

The Field's Children's Centre is funded to support families in the 5 key areas relating to staying safe, enjoying and achieving, making a positive contribution and being healthy.

The School catchment is the Abbey area, although the Children's Centre also supports rural areas of Fen Ditton, Horningsea and Quy.

Our Nursery School and Daycare:

In April 2019 we had 126 children aged between 0–4 on role.

38% are girls, 62% are boys,

are from Black and other Minority Ethnic Groups (BME)

different languages are spoken at the Field's

48 of our children have English as an additional language

26 were eligible for 2 year funding

37 were eligible for 30 hour childcare

Hindu, Muslim and Christian faiths are all represented in the Centre

We have a large proportion of children with additional educational needs.

We have 55 children with special educational needs (SEN) and/or a disability.

Our staff team:

The number of staff in our Centre is 37. In April 2019 our staff team consisted of the following groups:

Our Governing Body:
