



The Fields Nursery School Equality Information 2021/22

The Fields Nursery School comprises of a sessional nursery school provision and wraparound provision.

The Fields Nursery School provides:

- 104 part time places in education provision (15 hours per week)
- Wrap around childcare for working families

The Fields Nursery School is funded to support families in the 5 key areas relating to staying safe, enjoying and achieving, making a positive contribution and being healthy.

The School catchment is the Abbey area, although the Nursery School also supports rural areas of Fen Ditton, Horningsea and Quy.

Our Nursery School and wraparound care:

In April 2022 we had 78 children aged between 2–4 on role.

53% are girls, 47% are boys, of which there are:

9 2yr old boys (12%), 12 2yr old girls (15%)

17 3yr old boys (22%), 16 3yr old girls (20%)

11 4yr old boys (14%), 13 4yr old girls (17%)

45 are from Black and other Minority Ethnic Groups (BME)

24 different languages are spoken at the Fields

38 of our children have English as an additional language

17 were eligible for 2 year funding

24 were eligible for 30 hour funding

Hindu, Muslim and Christian faiths are all represented in the Nursery School.

We have a large proportion of children with additional educational needs.

We have 21 children with special educational needs (SEN) and/or a disability of which 13 children has speech and language support.

Our staff team:

The number of staff in our Nursery School is 20. In April 2022 our staff team consisted of the following groups:

A small proportion of our staff are from other ethnic backgrounds other than white British English Welsh Northern Irish Scottish.

The majority of our staff are heterosexual.

The Christian faith is held by half of our staff team (50%)

100% of our staff are female

60% of our staff consider themselves with no disability.
